

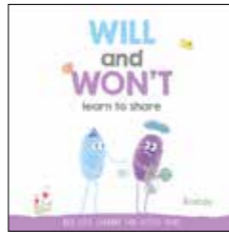
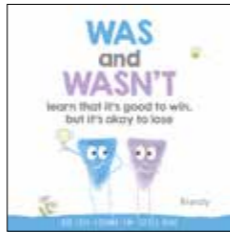
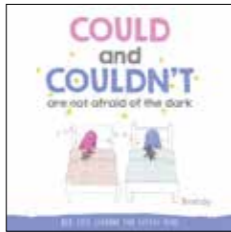
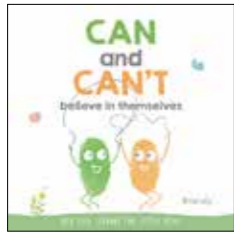


# Meet the CAN DOs

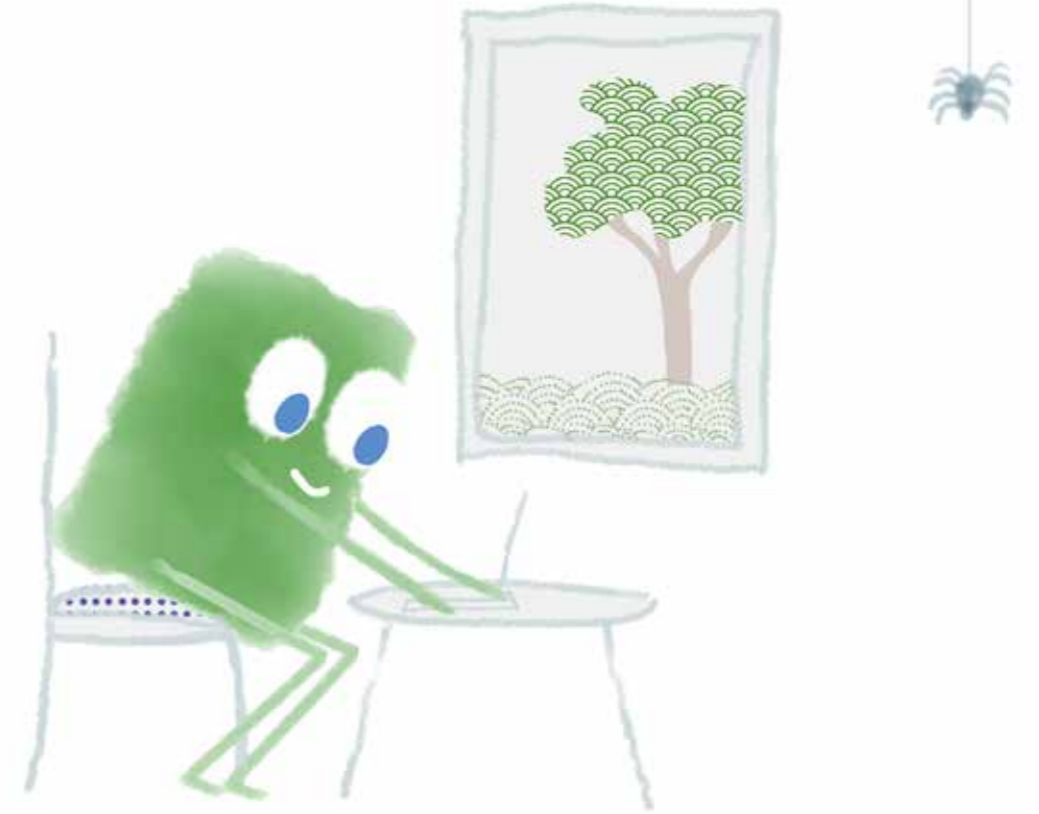

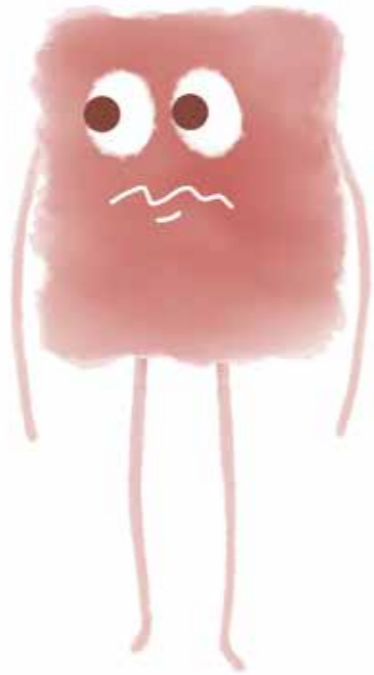

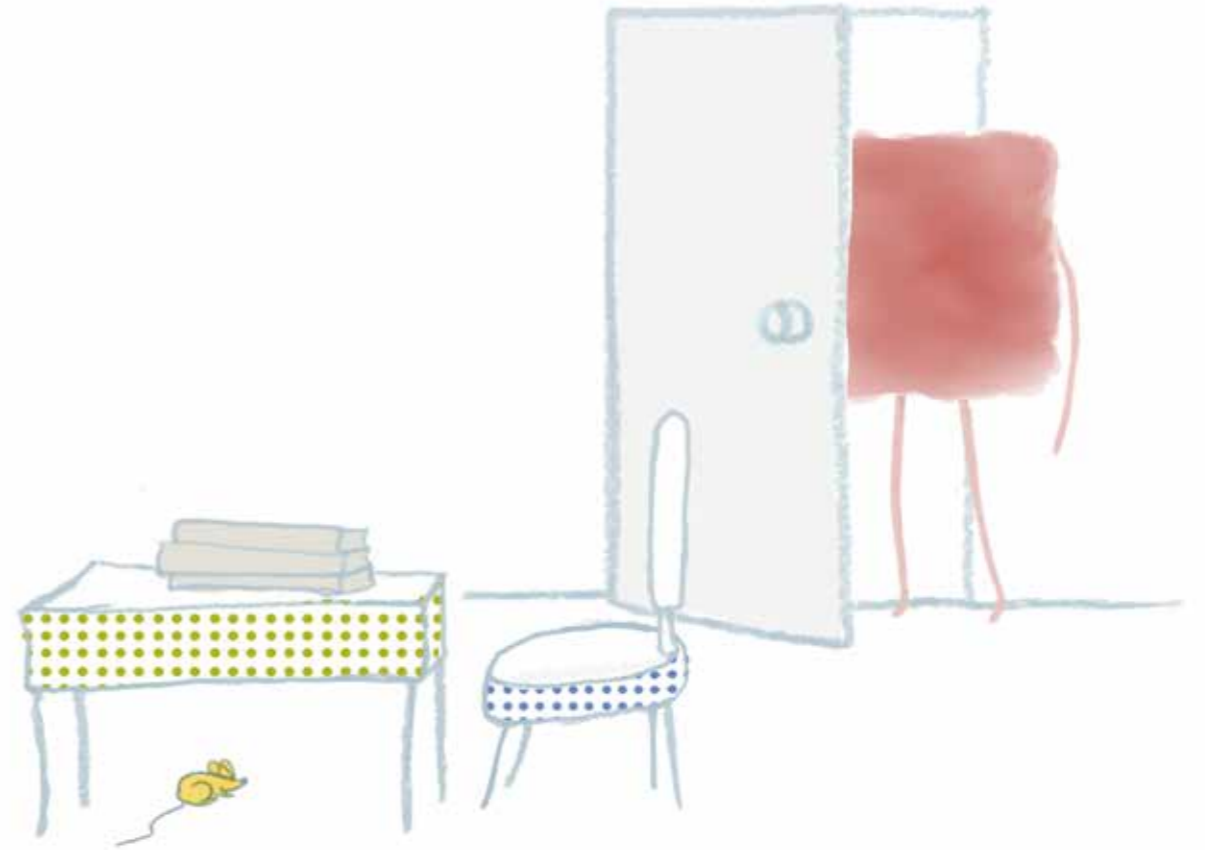
