Find out how you can be a hero too. Superpowers are not required; anyone can do it...

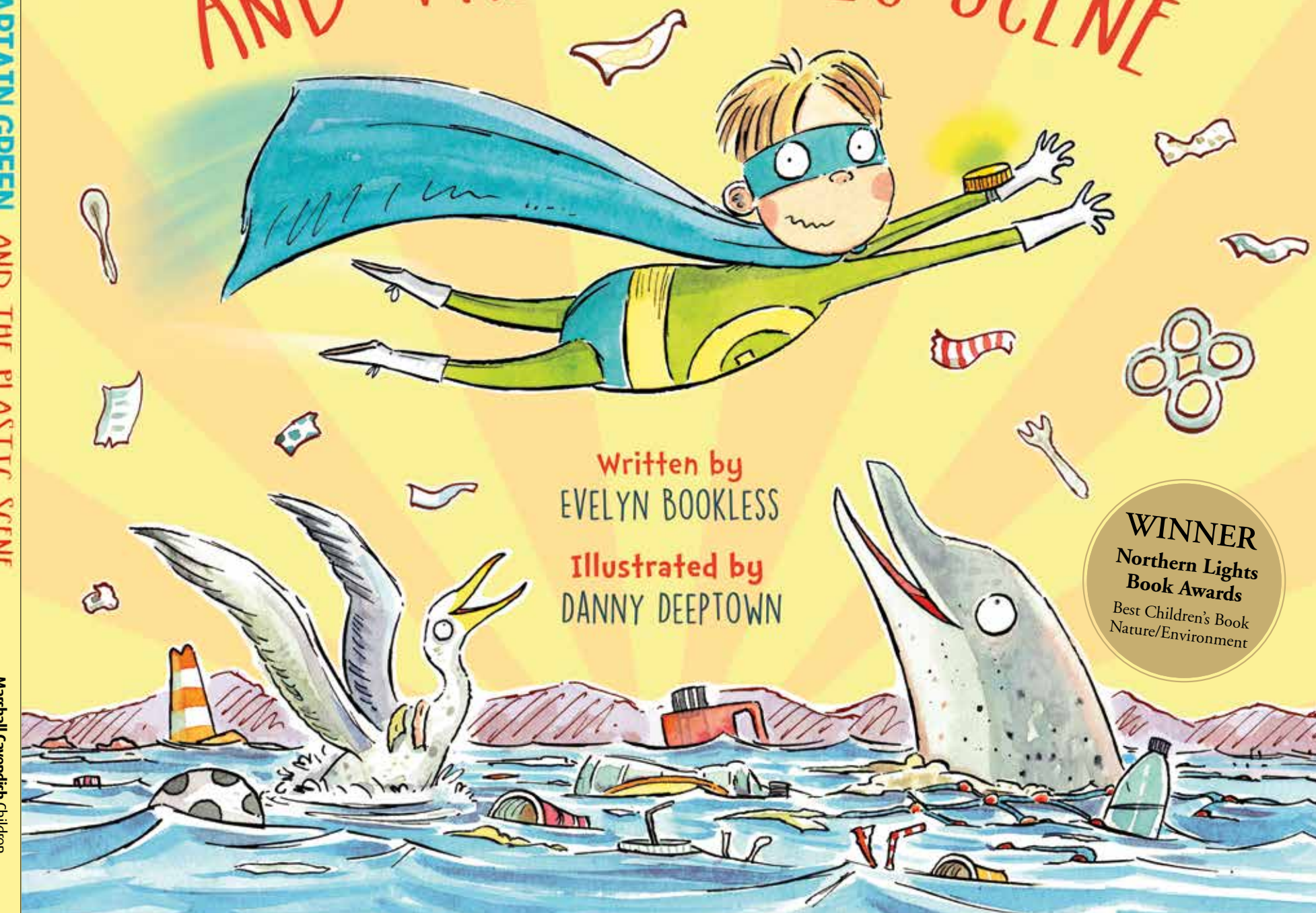

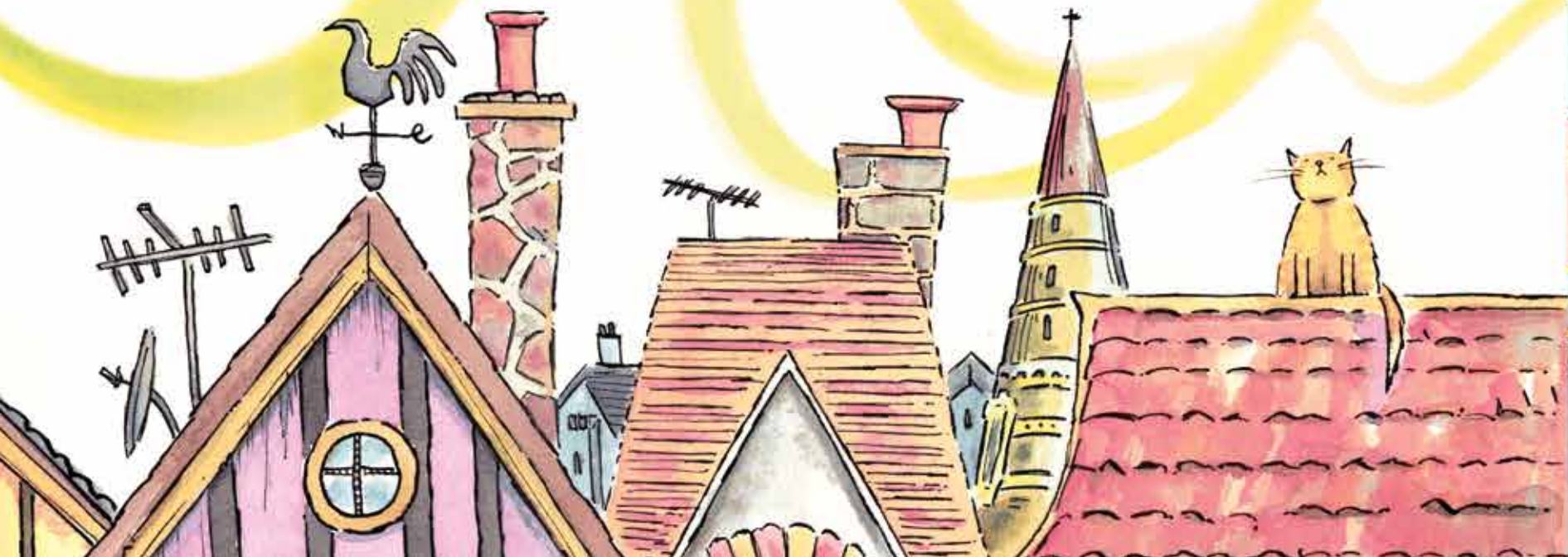

"It's time to practise my superhero skills."



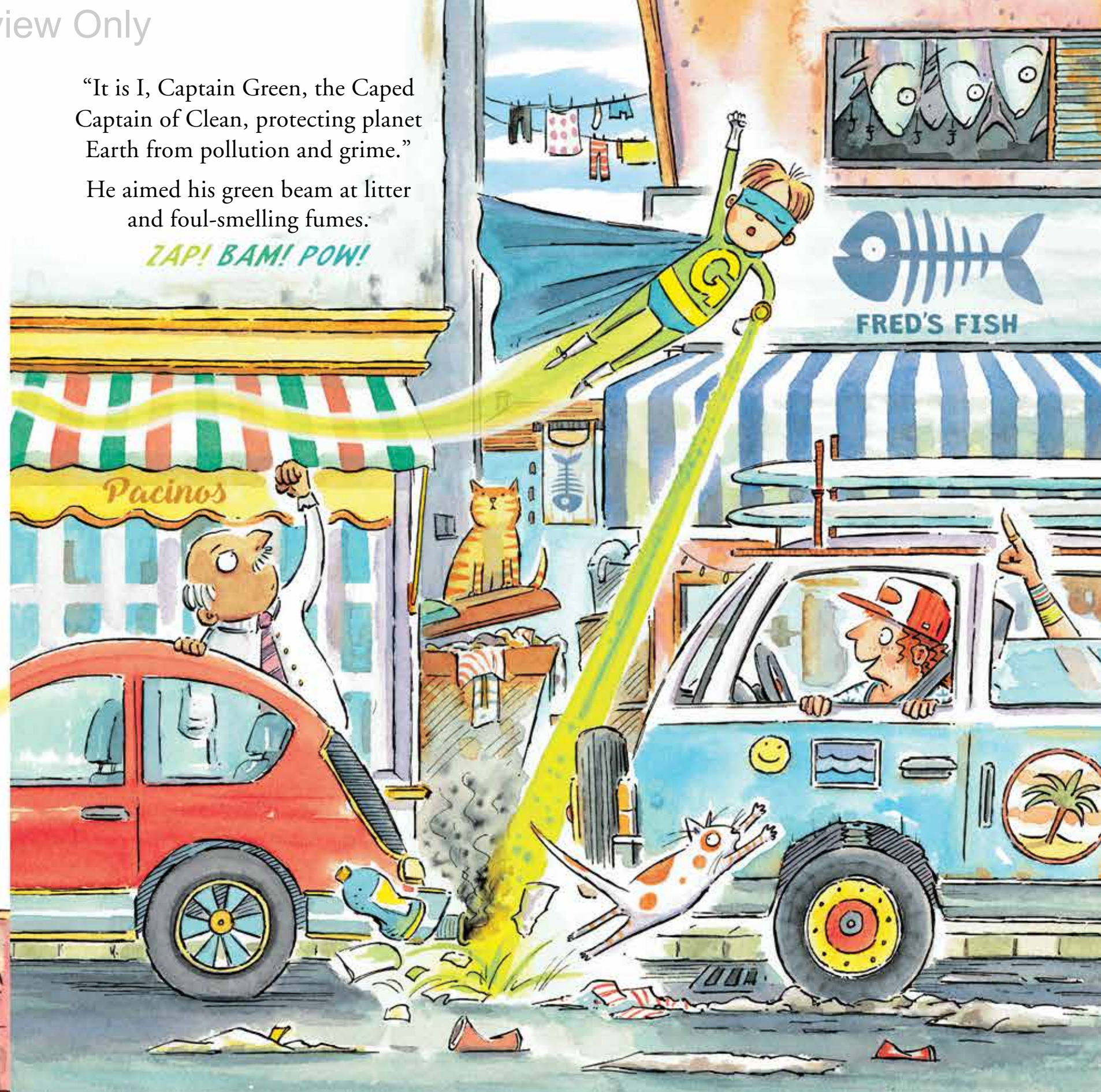
He swooped and he soared and then he declared...



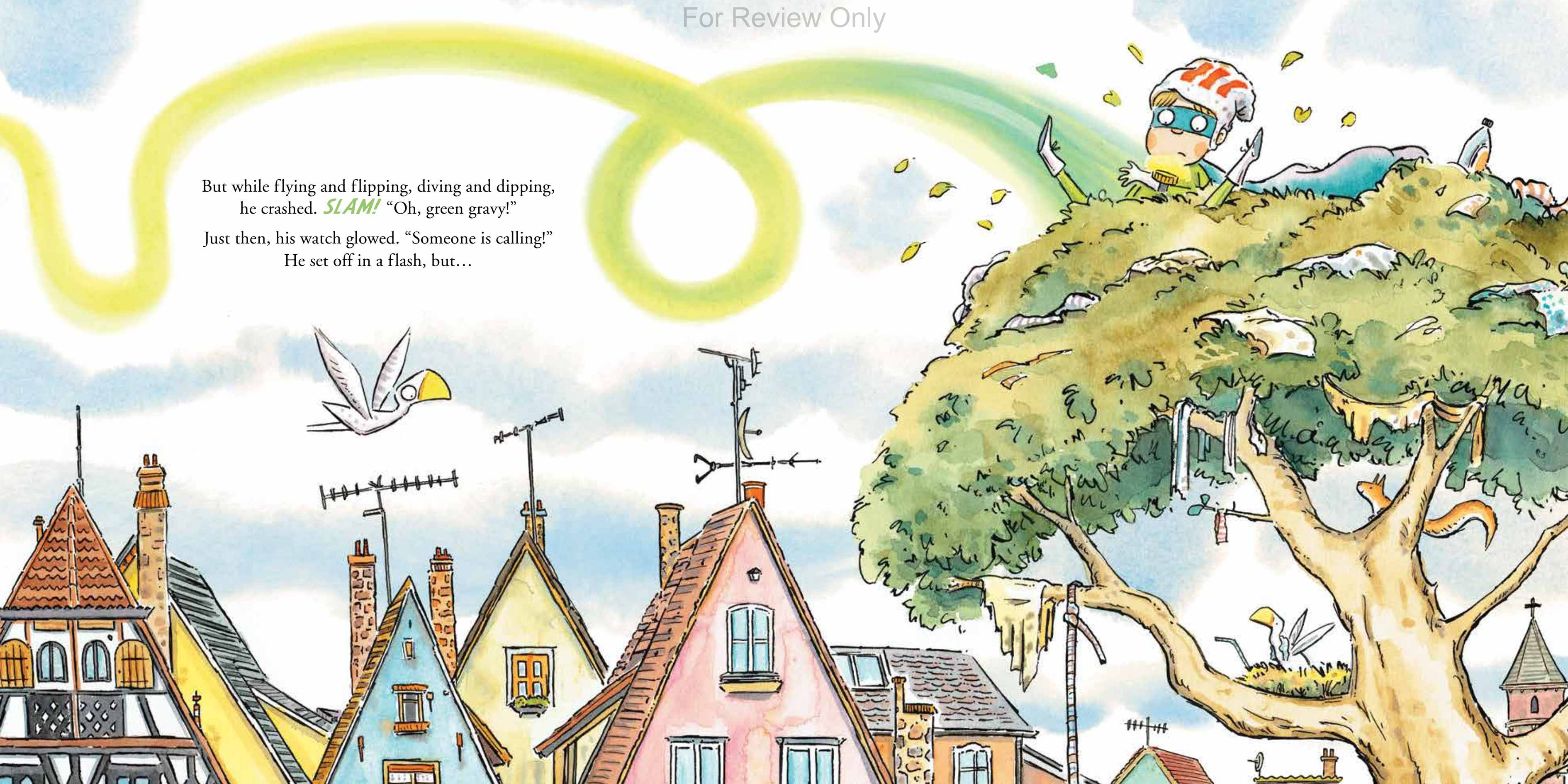
"It is I, Captain Green, the Caped Captain of Clean, protecting planet Earth from pollution and grime."

Dolphin was all tangled up.

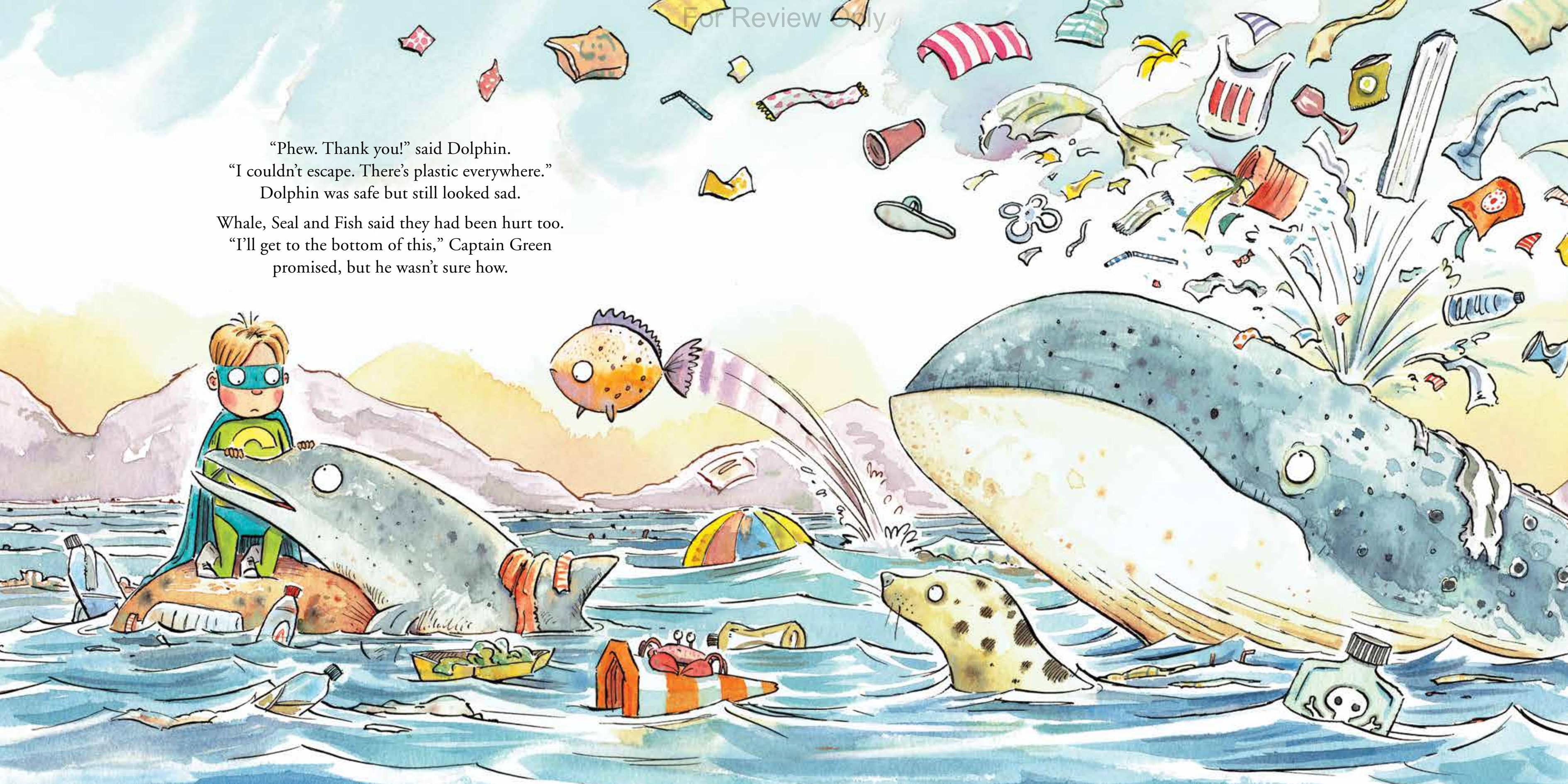


“Do not fear, the Captain is here!”
